

Why volunteer?

The tournament is run solely by volunteers, over 1300 were utilized for the 2008 event. All championship proceeds go to charities. The championship generated a record 3.5 M in 2008 bringing the total for the 6 years of the championship to 14M in charity dollars. The largest beneficiary is the Tiger Woods Foundation. Deutsche Bank and the Attleboro/Norton YMCA have developed a collaboration that benefits both organizations. YMCA volunteers not only contribute to an amazing event but have a direct impact on the fundraising efforts for the YMCA Best Friends...Kids and Their YMCA, Annual Support Campaign.

Why should you volunteer? The reasons are limitless. Some come for the social atmosphere and others for networking. Families can volunteer together as a fun summer activity and students can even fulfill their school's community service requirements. Many people enjoy working to give back in the community and raise money for local charities... and believe it or not, some still do it for the love of the game and the love of GOLF!

What will the Y Team volunteers be doing?

The Y team will be managing the PASE committee: **PLAYER & SPECTATOR EXPERIENCE:** Volunteers assist with the management of on-site foot traffic and cart traffic of players, spectators, volunteers and staff in order to ensure the safety of everyone involved. Volunteers are responsible for the safe and efficient travel of players and caddies throughout the course. Crosswalk management during these times is essential for players to meet their destination and continue the flow of play without interruption. Yes, we get to see all the players! No, we are not providing road way traffic control!

Dates/ Times

The Championship will be held Labor Day weekend at the Tournament Players Club of Boston, located in Norton, the week of September 1 – 7, 2009. Shifts begin as early as 6am and end as late as 7:30pm. You will be able to request your choices for your schedule in June or July.

What is included in the volunteer package?

The YMCA has made arrangements with the Championship to eliminate any volunteer fees that are charged to the general public when joining the Y Team.

YMCA team volunteers will receive a t-shirt and a visor for a uniform without a fee. Women may wear their own khaki pants, skirts or shorts of appropriate length. Men are encouraged to wear their own khaki pants, but if it is extremely hot, khaki shorts of appropriate length may be worn.

Y volunteers may still order the volunteer package should they want to take advantage of the discounted logo apparel in lieu of the free Y team package. Championship logo apparel: a golf shirt, a jacket, and either a cap or a visor. The volunteer uniform package is priced at \$80 (over \$350 value with credentials).

Both uniform packages include a week long credential for admission to the Championship at any time, a volunteer parking pass, meal vouchers, and a copy of the volunteer handbook. Admission to the on-site Volunteer Celebration Concert and an off-site Volunteer & Charity Appreciation party for you and a guest are also benefits given to all volunteers.

Are there minimum volunteer requirements?

Volunteers are requested to commit a minimum of 24 volunteer hours to the Championship. Age 14 and older. Additional Information and Signed Waiver form is required for those under age 18 years old.

How do I volunteer?

Completing the volunteer application adds your name to the Championship volunteer waitlist. The volunteer waitlist is made available to Committee Captains in need of new recruits to fill their committee roster. Returning committee members are given priority during the recruitment process. Positions are filled from the volunteer waitlist based on the date that an application is received and response time after being contacted by a committee captain.
