We can't wait to welcome everyone to the **Norton Outdoor Center** for tricks AND treats on Friday night!

While there is no registration required, we wanted to provide some helpful information to anyone who might be interested in attending!

- Trunk or Treat will run continuously from **6:30pm to 8:00pm** at our **Norton Outdoor Center**, **295 West Main Street, Norton, MA**. You do NOT need to arrive right at 6:30pm.
- Enter the **Norton Outdoor Center** via the road off West Main Street and park in the lower lot. There will be staff and volunteers to assist you.
- Once you have parked, there is a short walk up to our pool pavilion where kids can enjoy a quick craft before boarding our trail ride. The trail ride will travel up the rest of camp road around the front part of our upper field and drop families off directly at the trunks!
- Once you have visited all the trunks, be sure to stop by for some hot chocolate in our Fred M. Roddy Children's Pavilion; then head to the small pavilion to await transport back down the hill.
- Our trail ride can fit approximately 20 to 25 people per trip.
- Restrooms are available at the Fred M. Roddy Children's Pavilion.

What to Bring/Wear/Expect

- **Wear:** ALL are welcome and encouraged to come in costume! Please note that you may want to consider rain boots or water proof shoes as the field can hold water even when the day has been dry. Layer up as the temperature will drop as the sun goes down.
- **Bring:** Kids should bring a treat bag to fill as they visit the trunks and we strongly encourage flashlights! Although we have some lighting on site, we are out in the wilderness and it will be dark!
- **Expect:** Tons of fun and lots of candy! Trunks are providing their own treats, so kids and adults with food allergies should check their candy before eating. While we will have some options for kiddos with allergies, **Trunk or Treat** is **NOT** a nut-free event.
